Student Computer Contract

Below are policies that will regulate our use of the Internet and computer. These rules have been designed to keep our computer and classroom functioning at the highest of standards.

- 1. Students should not have food or drinks around technology.
- 2. Computers should only be used for educational use, only the programs the teacher allows.
 - a. Games, MySpace, Facebook, Internet Games, Youtube, chat rooms, Instant Messengers, Blog Websites, Fantasy Football/Basketball, etc are **NOT** permitted!!!
- 3. Students may not under any circumstances install software onto the computers.
- 4. Students hacking, altering unauthorized files, or using the network in any way other than that intended will loose their computer privileges.
- 5. Students must not move any equipment or cables. Keyboards and mice must not be swapped between machines.
- 6. Any behavior which threatens the physical safety of the equipment or other students will lead to the loss of privileges.
- 7. NEVER give a password to anyone!!!
- 8. No inappropriate language tolerated.
- 9. Students should not change their desktop, screensaver, etc.
- 10. Students should save on their Google Drives only.
- 11. Check your workstation everyday when you enter and leave the classroom. Inform your teacher if anything is wrong. The student is responsible for the laptop that is assigned to them in each classroom.
- 12. These are just to name a few. The students know what is acceptable and what is not.

Consequences:

1st offense: Call Home

2nd offense: Sent to the Dean of Students with a referral

3rd offense: Loss of computer privileges

These policies and procedures must be adhered to, and any violations of them will be met with zero tolerance.

- If this contract is broken, the student's privilege will be revoked.
